ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The nearest Airport is Calicut which is about 45 km. away from the Campus.

INFORMATION FOR ADHOC FACULTY APPLICANTS

The Institute proposes to conduct recruitment for the appointment of Ad-hoc Faculty in the various Department(s)/Centre(s) of the Institute for handling the academic teaching load in the Monsoon semester 2025-26. This engagement will be purely on temporary basis and will carry a consolidated pay as detailed below. Degrees from recognized Universities/Institutions will only be accepted. The candidates shall have first class in both UG and PG Level (60% or 6.5/10 CGPA, if not mentioned in the certificate). For SC/ST candidates, 55% marks (CGPA 6/10) both at UG and PG Level. **Those who have served the institute as Adhoc faculty for about 5 semesters are not eligible to apply.**

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The last date for submitting online application is 23-06-2025, 5.00 PM.
- Reservations are applicable as per the Govt. of India norms.
- Mere eligibility will not vest any right on any candidate for being called for interview. In all matters, the decision of the institute will be final.
- Canvassing in any manner will result in the disqualification of the candidate.
- Shortlisted candidates for the interview will be intimated through email only.
- The shortlisted candidates shall report in the concerned department/Centre at 08:00 am on the notified date. During the interview, the candidate might be asked to give a presentation on their area of specialization.
- No request for a change of interview schedule shall be entertained.
- No TA/DA shall be payable, and the candidates are required to make necessary boarding and lodging arrangements on their own.
- Selected candidates will be informed by e-mail, and they are expected to join immediately.



- Candidates who have defended Ph.D./ submitted Ph.D. thesis in the academic year 2024-25 can also apply. Those candidates who have submitted Ph.D. thesis have to produce poof of thesis submitted, failing which they will not be considered for interview.
- The candidates are required to attach the following documents along with the application.
 - (i) Valid Photo-ID
 - (ii) Date of birth certificate
 - (iii) All academic / professional certificates (Mark lists of all semesters/years and Degree/Provisional certificate of Ph.D./ Proof for the Ph.D. thesis submitted, PG, and UG Programmes undergone)
 - (iv) Caste certificate (SC / ST / Non-creamy layer OBC / EWS Certificate) from a competent authority. Non-creamy layer OBC / EWS Certificate obtained from a competent authority (not below the rank of a Tahsildar) should have been issued on or after 01/04/2025
 - (v) The PwBD category candidates should produce a certificate obtained from Medical Board concerned including the percentage of their infirmity at the time of interview.
 - (vi) Experience certificate
 - (vii) Re-prints of research publications
 - (viii) Any other information related to eligibility
- Applications without complete information/supporting documents will be rejected.
- If a candidate wishes to apply for more than one department/ Centre separate applications and fee payment need to be submitted.
- The qualifications and its corresponding remuneration will be fixed as prescribed. The remuneration would be on consolidated basis and no other allowances would be admissible.
