
#### Terms & conditions:

1. All these posts are tenure jobs for fixed duration under funded project.
2. These are not the regular posts under ICMR or AIIMS Nagpur.
3. Based on this experience, the selected candidate cannot claim any permanent employment either from ICMR or from AIIMS Nagpur
4. The appointment will be purely on a temporary basis for a period of one year.
5. In case the candidate wishes to resign from the post, he/she should furnish a notice of one month period.
6. Once the project duration is completed the tenure is automatically over for all the candidates selected for this project
